INFORMATION

Group Size: 8 people maximum, as well as your host and local guides

International flights are not included however we can help book these and include in your itinerary if requested.

Weather: In October, Namibia experiences warm to hot weather with daytime temperatures ranging from 25°C to 35°C and cooler nighttimes temperatures between 10°C and 20°C. Rainfall is minimal as it's part of the dry season although does start to fall towards the end of the month.

Accommodation on trail: While on the Tok Tokkie Trails we will be sleeping out under the stars. You will sleep out in the open on stretcher beds with a bedroll. If the weather is unfavourable, then tents will be provided.

Bathroom facilities comprise a long-drop toilet, bucket shower and hand basin at the overnight camps.

Currency: Namibia's currency is the Namibian Dollar. The South African Rand is also accepted in Namibia with equal value. There is a money exchange and several ATMs at Windhoek airport where you can exchange/withdraw local currency.

Visa & Passports: Please ensure your passport has validity at least 6 months after travel. Namibia offers many nationalities free visa which is granted upon arrival at customs

Travel Insurance: Insurance is mandatory. If you require insurance please do let me know.

Walking: We'll be walking no more than 10km per day. Walking will be at a low and steady pace but a general fitness level is required.



ITINERARY

Some timings and durations may change leading up to or during your trip as we work around any weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

For those looking to arrive earlier than the tour start date, accommodation arrangements can be made.



DAY 1: BAGATELLE KALAHARI GAME RANCH

Myself plus the local guide will welcome you at the airport and transfer you to the Kalahari Desert and to your home for the next 2 nights at Bagatelle Kalahari Game Ranch.

This 'Spirit of Africa' atmosphere, coupled with great service, delivered with graciousness and charm in a luxurious setting is the hallmark of this lodge.

DAY 2: BAGATELLE KALAHARI GAME RANCH

The morning starts walking with the San Bushman where they share their ancient survival skills and cultural traditions. In the afternoon we will enjoy a unique orphan cheetah experience which allows us to get up close to these incredible cats.


After this, a sundowner on the dune will await you, with refreshments and a Namibian snack, while you enjoy a breathtaking sunset in the Kalahari.

DAY 3: TOK TOKKIE TRAILS

The trails starts with a visit to the Namib Desert Environmental Education Trust. A scenic drive then takes you to the starting point of the Tok Tokkie Trail.

You will walk over a slope strewn with mysterious "fairy circles" and over rolling sand dunes to the first overnight camp.

At camp, relax with a sundowner, marvel at the magnificent scenery and enjoy this incredible International Dark Sky Reserve.

Walking time:

• 1-2 hrs at an easy pace

Overnight:

 Sleep under the stars on stretcher beds with Tok Tokkie Trails



DAY 4: TOK TOKKIE TRAILS

Early morning tea or coffee is served before sunrise followed by light breakfast.

You will then begin the walk over a mountain saddle before descending gently to a dry riverbed. For lunch we will stop at a shady spot to enjoy the chef's delicacies and fill up water bottles. Time to relax and siesta.

Once the heat recedes, we'll walk over the dunes to your second overnight spot. The scene is of endless dunes and "fairy circles" against a backdrop of magnificent mountain scenery.

A sundowner and delicious dinner ends your day.

Walking Time:

- Morning: 4 4.5 hours
- Afternoon: 2 2.5 hours

Overnight:

Sleeping out on an open stretcher bed





DAY 5: CAMP SOSSUS

After we arrive back at base camp, we will make our way to Camp Sossus.

You can either join us on an afternoon mountain bike adventure or relax at Camp Sossus and unwind by the pool.

We'll re-group for an evening sundowner out in nature. After the sun has set we will head back to camp for showers and enjoy a tasty dinner.

Activities:

- Morning walk to base camp with Tok Tokkie Trals
- Afternoon bike ride, walk or relax around camp.

DAY 6: CAMP SOSSUS

Today we'll visit the famous Sossusvlei in the Namib Naukluft National Park. We'll enter the park at sunrise so that we can enjoy the dunes whilst the light is soft and shadows accentuated, perfect for photographs.

We will also climb the most photographed dune in the world, Dune 45 and also see Deadvlei and climb "Big Daddy" dune.

This area boasts some of the highest freestanding sand dunes in the world.

Activities:

 Full Day exploring Sossusvlei and Namib Naukluft National Park.





DAY 7: SWAKOPMUND

Today we will make our way to Swakopmund, stopping at the famous Solitaire farm for lunch and to take some photos.

The rest of the afternoon is at leisure. Take a walk around the town, relax on the beach or recoup for our final day.

Today we will visit Spitzkoppe, known as the Matterhorn of Africa and one of Namibia's most recognisable landmarks.


We will have a guided walk around the rock formations, followed by a light lunch in nature.

Walking is easy, carry nothing but your day-pack. The pace is set to suit the group and the experienced desert guide will reveal the deserts wonders. 100 bird species, oryx, ostriches, golden moles, barking gecko's, scarabaeus and bat eared foxes can be found in the NamibRand Nature Reserve to name just a few.

SWAKOPMUND LUXURY SUITES


